1. INTRODUCTION:

Disability is defined as a lack of ability to perform an activity in the manner considered normal for a human being. As per 2011 census it is estimated that 2.21% population (approx.) suffer from one or other form of disability. For rehabilitation of such persons, the appropriate services need to be widely available.

The number of recognized disability conditions has been increased from 7 to 21 in the RPWD Act 2016 as follows:

1. Blindness
2. Low-vision
3. Leprosy Cured persons
4. Hearing Impairment (deaf and hard of hearing)
5. Locomotor Disability
6. Dwarfism
7. Intellectual Disability
8. Mental Illness
9. Autism Spectrum Disorder
10. Cerebral Palsy
11. Muscular Dystrophy
12. Chronic Neurological conditions
13. Specific Learning Disabilities
14. Multiple Sclerosis
15. Speech and Language disability
16. Thalassemia
17. Hemophilia
18. Sickle Cell disease
19. Multiple Disabilities including deaf-blindness
20. Acid Attack victim
21. Parkinson's disease

The Government, NGOs and civil society Institutions have been providing services to the Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan) since long, but these efforts have gained momentum since 1970's when the decade was marked by a new approach to disability with the concept of "Rights for Disabled Persons". The United Nations took the lead and issued declarations relating to Rights to the Disabled Persons (1975). The decade 1983-92 was declared as the "Decade of the Disabled Persons". This was followed by the "Asia and Pacific Decade of Disabled Persons" (1993-2002). The standard rules for the equalization of opportunities for persons with disabilities were adopted by the UN General Assembly in 1993.

Since 1970, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India has established several Institutions to train professionals/ manpower in the field of rehabilitation. There are Ten National Institutes:

- (i) Swami Vivekanand National Institute of the Rehabilitation Training and Research (SVNIRTAR), Cuttack
- (ii) National Institute for Locomotor Disabilities (NILD), Kolkata
- (iii) National Institute for Empowerment of Persons with Multiple Disabilities (NIEPMD), Chennai
- (iv) Pt. Deendayal Upadhyaya National Institute for Persons with Physical Disabilities (PDUNIPPD), Delhi
- (v) Ali Yavar Jung National Institute of Speech and Hearing Disabilities (AYJNISHD), Mumbai
- (vi) National Institute for the Empowerment of Persons with Visual Disabilities (NIEPVD), Dehradun
- (vii) National Institute for the Empowerment of Persons with Intellectual Disabilities (NIEPID), Secunderabad
- (viii) Indian Sign Language Research & Training Centre (ISLRTC), New Delhi
- (ix) National Institute of Mental Health and Rehabilitation (NIMHR), Sehore, Madhya Pradesh
- (x) Atal Bihari Vajpayee Training Centre for Disability Sports, Gwalior.

These Institutes are conducting education programs at Degree and Postgraduate level in their respective disciplines. The Institute also carries out Research; develop models of rehabilitation services, manpower development, and clinical & therapeutic services. They also have extensive outreach programs so that services are available in a decentralized manner. Over the years, the Institutes have trained thousands of professionals who are working all over the Country and abroad. 2.1 Swami Vivekanand National Institute of Rehabilitation Training and Research (DIVYANGJAN), (SVNIRTAR), Cuttack:-

SVNIRTAR is located at Olatpur, PO-Bairoi, in the District of Cuttack, Odisha 30 kms away from Cuttack and Bhubaneswar. It has well-developed Departments in Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Prosthetics & Orthotics, Speech & Hearing and Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation. It has 200 bedded Hospital where surgeries are performed for correction of deformities. The Institution is strong in research and has a fair amount of published work. The faculties are of National and International repute. The Institute is running Bachelor's Degree programs in Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy and Prosthetics & Orthotics, Audiology and Speech Language Pathology courses. Ali Yavar Jung National Institute of Speech and Hearing Disabilities (Divyangjan), AYJNISHD(D) was established on 9th August 1983. It is an autonomous organisation under the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan), Government of India, New Delhi and is located at Bandra (West), Mumbai. It is an approved Science & Technology Institute of Govt. of India. Regional Centres of the institute have been established in Kolkata (1984), New Delhi (1986), Secunderabad (1986) and Bhubaneswar (1986- in association with the Government of Orissa). These are centres aimed at meeting local and regional needs in terms of manpower development and services. Regional Centre in New Delhi has been shifted to Noida in 2015 and the Regional Centre at Bhubaneswar has been shifted to Janla in 2008.

3. ELIGIBILITY: The minimum qualification is as follows:

M.P.O.	BPO/ B.Sc. There is no upper age limit.

5. RESERVATION

5.1 Vertical Reservation: Reservation will be made as per the Central Govt. norms i.e. EWS- 10%, SC- 15%, ST- 7.5% and OBC- 27% are kept vertically subject to production of Original Caste Certificate. However, the candidates must appear in PG Entrance Test -2026 and qualify according to the minimum norms applicable to them.

5.2 Horizontal Reservation: Horizontal reservation will be provided to meritorious Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) (Divyangjan), North East (NE) States candidates subject to non-availability of such candidates during vertical reservation. The seat will be deducted from the candidate's category (UR/SC/ST/OBC/EWS). Reservation of Seats for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD)/PH (Divyangjan) will be provided as per Govt. of India guidelines and Reservation roaster. For SVNIRTAR, 01 Seat for North East (NE) State candidates in each i.e. MPT/MOT/MPO courses are reserved horizontally from respective categories (UR, SC, ST, EWS & OBC).

5.2.1 PwBD/ PH Reservation: Govt. of India reservation policy for PwBD/PH (Divyangjan) candidates will be strictly followed in each course i.e. MPT, MOT & MPO subject to production of Original PwD/PH (Divyangjan)/UDID Certificate issued from Competent Authority. In case of PwD candidates are not allotted seat during vertical reservation, then, the meritorious PwBD/PH (Divyangjan) candidate from PwD/PH (Divyangjan) rank will get the chance and the seat will be deducted from the candidate's category (UR/SC/ST/OBC/EWS). 01 seat in MPO is reserved for meritorious PwBD/PH (Divyangjan) candidate as per Reservation Roaster for this Academic year i.e. 2026-27 at SVNIRTAR.

5.2.2 NE State Reservation: At SVNIRTAR One seat in each course i.e. MPT, MOT & MPO is reserved for candidates from North Eastern State. In case of NE candidates are not allotted seat during vertical reservation, then the meritorious NE candidate from NE rank will get the chance on production of original Domicile/Nativity/Residence Certificate issued from the Competent Authority and the seat will be deducted from the candidate's category (UR/SC/ST/OBC/EWS).

Reservation will be made as per the Central Govt. norms. However, the candidates must appear in PG Entrance Test -2026 and qualify according to the minimum norms applicable to them.

The SC/ST candidates are required to submit Caste Certificate from appropriate authorities on the basis of which reservation is claimed.

SEBC Certificate issued by Govt. of Odisha or any State Govt. BC certificates applicable for their concerned state will not be accepted. OBC Certificate (Non Creamy layer) issued in Govt. of India format only (Sample format available in Page No- 19) and issued on or after 01.04.2026 will be accepted. OBC certificate issued before 01.04.2026 will not be accepted. In case of non-availability of qualified OBC candidates, the vacant seats will be filled-up by open Category candidates in order of merit.

EWS Certificate issued by Competent authority (For Candidates seeking EWS Reservation) issued on or after 01.04.2026 will be accepted. EWS certificate issued before 01.04.2026 will not be accepted.

Issued before 01/10/2020 will not be accepted.

6. POST GRADUATE ENTRANCE TEST-2026

All the above seats shall be filled through Post Graduate Entrance Test (PGET-2026) conducted by the Institute. Indian Nationals residing in India or abroad /Foreign Nationals particularly from neighboring South East Asian Countries seeking admission as per eligibility are required to appear the **POST GRADUATE ENTRANCE TEST, PGET-2026**. The test will carry 100 marks. Duration of the test will be 90 minutes.

7. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION & SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM

7.1. General Instructions:-

- i) Log in to <https://admission.svnirtar.nic.in>
- ii) The candidates are required to **apply only online** as per the procedure detailed below:
 - a. Candidates can apply for PGET - 2026 only through “**Online**” mode only.
 - b. Information Brochure can be downloaded from the website <https://admission.svnirtar.nic.in>

- c. Online submission of Application Form may be made by accessing PGET-2026 from the Institute website <https://admission.svnirtar.nic.in>
 - d. Instructions for Online submission of Application Form are available in Information Brochure and on the website <https://admission.svnirtar.nic.in>
 - e. Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as given in the Information Brochure available on the website (<https://admission.svnirtar.nic.in>). Candidates not complying with the instructions shall summarily be disqualified
 - f. Candidates must retain the following documents with them as reference for future correspondence.)
 - i. Printouts of the computer generated Confirmation Page of the Application Form.
 - ii. Proof of fee payment.
 - g. The fee can be remitted through any of the following methods :
 - i. By Debit Card/ Credit Card/ Internet Banking/UPI.
 - h. The candidates should provide all the authentic details while filling up the online form. On submission of details, a Registration Number shall be generated.
 - i. Candidate has to fill the particulars online and also upload the following documents during filling up the online form:
 - i. Recent passport size photograph
 - ii. Signature
 - iii. Left Thumb Impression
 - iv. Caste Certificate (For Candidates seeking Category Reservation). **For OBC category reservation, the OBC Certificate (Non Creamy layer) issued by competent authority on or after 01.04.2026 in Govt. of India format only will be accepted. OBC certificate issued before 01.04.2026 will not be accepted. (Sample format available in Page No- 19)**
 - v. EWS Certificate issued by competent authority (For Candidates seeking EWS Reservation) **issued on or after 01.04.2026 will be accepted. EWS certificate issued before 01.04.2026 will not be accepted.**
 - vi. PwD/PH (Divyangjan) Certificate/UDID Card (For Candidates seeking Reservation under PwD/PH Category) with minimum 40% Disability.
 - vii. Residence/ Domicile/ Nativity Certificate issued from Competent Authority (For Candidates seeking Reservation under NE Category & Telengana Quota)
- Due to the above procedure, it is not necessary to send the hard copy of the application i.e. confirmation page to the SVNIRTAR office.
- j. However, the candidates are advised to retain a hard copy of the application i.e. confirmation page along with proof of money transfer for future reference or correspondence, if any.
 - k. Applicant must quote the registration number/ Application number generated after submission of all his/her required personal data as a reference in all his/her future correspondence with SVNIRTAR regarding PGET-2026.
 - l. Application must be completed in all respect. Incomplete/ unsuccessful submission of application will lead to outright rejection. Completed application means:
 - i. Completion of Registration.
 - ii. Uploading of scanned copy of photograph, signature, left hand thumb impression and any other documents as required.
 - iii. Payment of the required fee if applicable.
 - iv. Generation/downloading of payment receipt and Confirmation Page

- v. Options such as Category and vertical Reservation & horizontal reservation category once given by the applicant in the application form cannot be changed afterwards under any circumstances. Options for Entrance Test Centres once filled cannot be changed by the candidate. However, in unavoidable circumstances the Examination Centre may be changed by Chairman, PGET-2026 Cum-Director
- vi. Please note that name, father's name and date of birth should be as recorded in the 10th class or equivalent certificate. Any deviation may lead to cancellation of your candidature, whenever noticed.
- vii. Applicant should give options only with respect to category UR (Unreserved Caste), OBC (Other Backward Caste), SC (Schedule Caste), ST (Scheduled Tribe), EWS (Economically Weaker Section), PH (Physically Handicapped) (Divyangjan) and NE (North Eastern States). The candidate can substantiate the same with documentary evidences during document verification cum admission/Counseling.
- viii. Candidates are allowed to submit only one application form. Multiple applications for a particular stream or in multiple streams of a candidate are liable to be rejected.
- ix. **Application fee once paid is non-refundable.**
- x. Candidates may check the status of their application on PGET -2026 from <https://admission.svnirtar.nic.in> website by giving the registration number/ application number (Chosen User ID) and Password that is created during registration.
- xi. Any dispute arising out of PGET-2026 shall only be settled and decided under the jurisdiction of Hon'ble High Court of Odisha.
- xii. Claim for admission will be rejected if the candidate cannot submit the original certificates, mark sheets, other necessary documents at the time of document verification cum admission/Counseling or if one has filled the form wrongly. No undertaking will be allowed.
- xiii. Admission will be cancelled at any time, if certificates/ mark sheets/ other documents are found to be forged or manipulated. A candidate will not be considered for admission if he/she fails to substantiate the claim with respect to reservation, category, nativity, date of birth, qualification etc.
- xiv. Facility of submission of application form and online payment will be ceased at **11.59 PM on** closing date. Hence, candidates are required to complete the process within the prescribed duration.
- xv. PLEASE FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS GIVEN BELOW BEFORE SUBMITTING THE ON-LINE APPLICATION FORM: -
 - i. Follow all the instructions in filling up the form and you should have gone through the important notes carefully.

9. SELECTION PROCEDURE FOR COUNSELLING AND ADMISSION

The admission to the above courses will be made strictly on the basis of rank based upon the marks obtained in PGET-2026.

In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in the PGET-2026, the inter-merit of candidates will be determined according to the following criteria:-

- i. The candidates getting higher marks in Final year/ (7th + 8th) Semester/ Part-IV in BPT/B.Sc.(PT), BOT/B.Sc.(OT), BPO/B.Sc.(P&O)/ BASLP shall rank higher in the merit list.
- ii. In case of tie in (i) above, the candidates securing total higher marks in BPT/B.Sc.(PT), BOT/B.Sc.(OT), BPO/ B.Sc.(P&O)/ BASLP shall rank higher in the merit list.
- iii. In case of tie in (i& ii) above, the candidate elder in age shall rank higher.

As the merit list will be generated based on the marks secured in qualifying examination and date of birth (in case of tie) provided by candidate during submission of application form, the candidate will lose the right for admission if the information provided is found to be incorrect during document verification.

10. CHOICE FILLING, LOCKING, SEAT ALLOTMENT, AND DOCUMENT VERIFICATION

Separate merit list will be drawn for each course MPT, MOT, MPO & M.SC. AUDIOLOGY. All candidates irrespective of their Rank are required to login the website <https://admission.svnirtar.nic.in> for **REGISTRATION AND CHOICE FILLING, LOCKING FOR CHOICE OF SPECIALTY AREA/ CHOICE OF INSTITUTE BETWEEN 18.07.2026 TO 21.07.2026. FAILING WHICH THE CANDIDATE WILL NOT BE ALLOTTED ANY SEAT DURING SEAT ALLOTMENT PROCESS.** Candidates are advised to fill choices in the order of preference taking course and specialization into consideration and submit maximum number of choices in order to avoid un-allocation.

After completion of choice locking period, seat allocation will be done by the system considering merit rank, reservation rule, availability of seat, and choices filled. System will allocate the best possible preference of choice from the list of choices submitted. Once seat allotment result is declared, candidates can login to the admission portal and complete the following activities:

All the candidates who have completed the above steps will be called to the allotted Institute for document verification. Candidates who will not complete the above activities within the scheduled date/time, their allocated seat will be cancelled.
